- Programming, deployment and maintenance of all network power resources (power supply and power distribution units).
- Maintenance of Windows Active Directory infrastructure.
- Deployment and maintenance of Microsoft Office 365/Windows Azure Active Directory infrastructure.
- Test and deploy software applications and systems.
- Design and implement system security and data assurance.
- Design and implement disaster recovery plan.
- Create flowcharts, diagrams, and other documentation with regards to network infrastructure and resources.
- Design, deployment and maintenance of DHCP and static addressing architecture.
- Design, deployment and maintenance of both internal and external DNS architectures.
- Work with organization leadership to develop and deploy both new and existing technology solutions with the aim to further organizational goals.

- Ability to design, deploy and troubleshoot all aspects of a Windows domain and the underlying infrastructure.
- Ability to use PC/Network performance diagnostic and tuning tools.
- Ability to communicate effectively and professionally both orally and in writing.
- Excellent interpersonal skills, including the ability to interact with a wide variety of personalities while managing rapidly shifting priorities.
