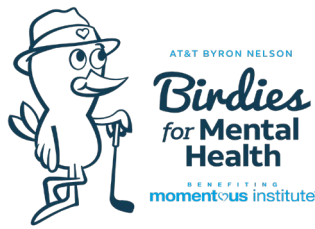


**AT&T BYRON NELSON
BIRDIES FOR MENTAL HEALTH
OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES**

1. No pledge, purchase or donation is required to participate in the AT&T Byron Nelson Birdies for Mental Health contest or to become eligible to receive a prize. A pledge will not increase a participant's likelihood of winning a prize.
2. The AT&T Byron Nelson Birdies for Mental Health contest is open to all participants who are 18 years of age or older. The contest is void where prohibited or restricted by law. Directors, Members, Officers, Volunteers, Employees and their immediate families of the AT&T Byron Nelson, Salesmanship Club of Dallas, Salesmanship Club Charitable Golf of Dallas, Inc., Momentous Institute or PGA TOUR, Inc. are **not** eligible for the prizes.
3. Prize winners will be announced and awarded no later than 30 days after the final official day of the 2022 AT&T Byron Nelson ("Tournament") play. A participant need not be present to win.
4. One contest entry per person.
5. The exact number of birdies made during the Tournament will also include any birdies made during Tournament playoff rounds. By definition, a birdie is achieved when a player is one stroke under par of the hole.
6. Should PGA TOUR Tournament Officials cancel one or more rounds of Tournament play because of weather or other conditions, then that day's winner will be randomly drawn. The total so determined shall be the "Total Number of Birdies only" made during the AT&T Byron Nelson for all purposes, specifically including the AT&T Birdies for Mental Health contest and the awarding of the Grand Prize.
7. Guesses for all prizes will end on Wednesday, May 11, 2022, at 9 p.m.CST
8. Tournament officials will announce the final number of birdies made except as provided for herein.
9. Contest will begin on February 15, 2022 and will extend through Wednesday, May 11, 2022 during AT&T Byron Nelson tournament week. Only guesses made on official entry forms will be eligible for prizes. No photocopies. No exceptions. Official entry forms must be obtained online at the specified web pages at www.attbyronnelson.org or at the AT&T Byron Nelson tournament office located at 106 E 10th Street, Dallas, TX 75203.
10. The Judges' decisions and interpretations of these Rules will be final and will be made in their sole and absolute discretion. No appeal of further review will be permitted. Tournament Chairman/Director will appoint the contest Judges.
11. Prizes may not be exchanged for cash. A list of all prize winners may be obtained upon written request to the Tournament office.
12. Prizes are taxable and winners are responsible for any and all sales taxes and income taxes on all prizes, including all local, state, and federal taxes. The tournament will issue a Misc-1099 for prizes valued over \$600. Prize winners have the option of either accepting the Prize including the above stated taxes & fees; or the Prize winner has the option to decline the Prize.
13. Certain prizes may be limited in size and type. All prizes must be picked up at the AT&T Byron Nelson Tournament Office within forty- five (45) days after notification of award is mailed to participant. All unclaimed prizes will be forfeited.
14. Clear, legible handwriting is the responsibility of all participants. The Tournament shall not be responsible for any errors caused by poor penmanship.
15. The AT&T Byron Nelson is not responsible for and will not accept any entry forms received after Wednesday, May 11, 2022.
16. These rules may be amended without notice at any time in the sole and absolute discretion of Tournament Officials.
17. All prizes are subject to change without notice at any time in the sole and absolute discretion of Tournament Officials.
18. Donors will receive a receipt at time of payment for a donation or pledge with the following statement. "Please accept this acknowledgement as an official receipt in compliance with IRS regulations. No goods or services were provided in return for your contribution. Please check with your personal tax advisor regarding the deductibility of your gift as it may be tax-deductible to the fullest extent permitted by law.
